

Principle XI -- engaged scholarship

Schools, departments, and colleges of education should be engaged in research and scholarship that is based on problems that schools face, as well as established theory and research, that addresses the problems articulated by the schools.

Principle XI - evidence based programs

Schools, departments, and colleges of education engage in research on and evaluation of their own programs to determine for themselves and the larger community, what produces highly effective teachers, administrators, and school personnel?

Principle XII - - make a difference in schools

Schools, departments, and colleges of education work with schools to enhance student success.

Process:

1. Get teacher voices in it; National Association for Prof Dev Schools.
2. Principles have to be articulated so that operationalization or enactments of the principles is clear and not contradictory.
3. OK for deans to sign on to it, but we need to bring I our faculties; may be valuable in the process of examining the principles.
4. Get consensus within CADREI and then do something that gets attention: Call it a manifesto.
