Activism


- 'aktə vizəm/

2. Be willing to stand for the right though the Heavens fall




4. Have an affirmative vision, one that shows what you are for, not just what you are against


5. Offer viable, doable, alternatives 6. Say what you mean and mean what you say.


7. Keep your legislative liaison informed and in the loop 8. Understand your Provost and President


