- Pre-award
- Post-award

Assistance with
external funding

- Identifying opportunities
- Assistance with budget & required proposal components (e.g., data management plan)
- Liaison with central grants office
- Identifying collaborators; building teams
- Technical editing
- Establishing timelines

Pre-award

- Working with institutional systems
 - Travel
 - Personnel
 - Purchasing
- Budget updates and projections
- Reporting
- Monitoring restrictions
- Close-out

Post-award

- Workshops: funder-specific strategies, advice on writing, government vs foundations, creating and managing collaborations, talking to funders, local resources, responsible research
- Structures for proposal review and revision
- Finding and using mentors
- Seed funding

Faculty Development
